



Instructions

1. Print all pages onto letter size white card stock.
2. Cut out cover image and answer key along the lines.
3. Glue answer key to the **back** of the cover image **before** laminating it.
 - I recommend Elmer's Rubber Cement because it is acid free.
 - Let it dry completely before laminating.
4. The bush with the orange leaves should be cut into 2 sections.
Laminate each one separately. Trim the edges.
5. The bush will need to be folded in half to fit inside the pencil pouch. Laminated card stock is too stiff to fold well. Therefore, lay the 2 cut out pieces of bush side by side with about 1/8" separating them. Tape the 2 pieces together with piece of tape on the front and a different piece of tape on the back. You can now easily fold the bush in half.
6. Laminate the yellow flame pages and cut out each yellow flame.
7. Place everything in a 3-ring binder pencil pouch that has a clear plastic window.
They are now ready for many years of use.
